



Applications invited for the position of Project Manager – Institute of Livelihood Research and Training (ILRT)

Background

The Institute of Livelihood Research and Training – ILRT (www.iltindia.org) is an academic institution promoted by the Basix Social Enterprise Group (Basix SEG), a livelihood promotion institution. The mandate of the ILRT is to build up a scientific knowledge base on livelihoods and disseminate the same to livelihood practitioners for enhancing their understanding and implementation capabilities, who in turn will promote large number of livelihoods.

ILRT is implementing an action research project titled 'Integrating Farm and Non-Farm Value Chains in Producers Collectives: A Market oriented Business Connect Initiative in Chhindwara' under project Prabhat, A Community Initiative of Hindustan Unilever Limited (HUL) with the support of Indian Grameen Services (IGS). The project intends to promote Farm and Non-Farm sector-based livelihoods including value chain development.

ILRT is seeking dynamic persons to take up the position of Project Manager at Chhindwara.

The position involves coordination of a livelihood promotion project. Both farm sector and non-farm sector-based enterprises would be promoted. Value chain interventions, Skill training programs & promotion, entrepreneurship trainings and facilitation of enterprises, promotion of farmer producer organization would be undertaken. An experience in promoting farm and non-farm-based enterprises would be preferred. The position would involve networking with a range of stakeholders – governmental, civil society and private sector. The project manager would be working with a team. The project would be carried out in surrounding 13 villages of HUL plant area in Chhindwara. The target group would be women and youth.

Required skill and experience

Postgraduate in Rural Management, Agri-business Management, Agriculture, Development Studies and other related subjects.

Professional Experience

About 5 years' experience in livelihood promotion, agri-value chain and agri-business development, micro-enterprise promotion, promotion of community collectives such as SHGs and FPOs, skill development, livelihood project management, etc.
